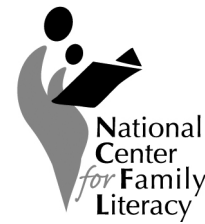

Parent Time: A Key to Understanding DVD Kit \$75

This 20-minute DVD is an excellent introduction to the power of parent involvement in children's education. Strategies for planning and implementing effective Parent Time sessions are reviewed in depth, plus three real-life vignettes provide opportunities for viewers to observe and discuss. An accompanying booklet and PowerPoint presentation includes notes for facilitators to support and enhance Parent Time training. *This kit is also available with a VHS video in Spanish. Booklet and CD are in English.* (2003)

PACT Time in the Elementary School DVD Kit \$75

This DVD kit provides teachers and/or parents the opportunity to see PACT Time for school-age children (ages 5–12) in action. Recruitment & Retention for Literacy Programs Kit \$55

Tools, resources and guidance that every literacy program needs! This kit includes a guidebook filled with straightforward ideas for engaging students and keeping them motivated. Also comes with posters, postcards and bookmarks in English and Spanish that programs can customize to increase community visibility, and includes a CD-Rom with useful forms and templates. (2005)

Recruitment & Retention Guidebook \$26

Strategies culled from practitioners working in the field are highlighted throughout this guide, which also examines adult motivation, goal setting, tips for planning recruitment events, and much more. *(Included as part of the Recruitment & Retention for Literacy Programs Kit listed above.)* (2005)

Stories of Impact: Improving Parent Involvement Through Family Literacy in the Elementary School \$14

Examines how family literacy impacts children's outcomes by increasing parent involvement and helping parents improve their own language and literacy skills. Also provides real program examples of blended funding opportunities, plus student and teacher success stories from the Toyota Families in Schools program, a five-year initiative implemented in 45 Title I schools. Work-Focus Strategies for Family Literacy Programs \$19

This comprehensive publication traces the history, research and implementation behind educational initiatives to move adults from welfare to work. For practitioners and administrators alike, the book explores curriculum content adaptations and offers a wealth of hands-on resources and tools drawn from work-focused programs. (2003)

Pathways: A Primer for Family Literacy Program Design and Development \$21

This practical guide explores the steps for starting and maintaining a quality family literacy program, from initial community assessment to strategies for ongoing success that include evaluation, recruitment and retention, and raising public awareness. This comprehensive guidebook for teachers and administrators of family literacy programs is the definitive reference on family literacy curriculum development, the four components of a comprehensive program, component integration, home visits and more. (1997)

This guidebook provides easy-to-digest information about the funding process, from developing a case and defining objectives to gaining ongoing support from funders. Also offers an overview of public and private funding opportunities for family literacy, plus tip sheets and local program examples. (2002)

This how-to guide walks you through steps you can take to actively engage elected officials and other opinion makers in the work you do. Tips on planning site visits, writing to legislators, and working with the media make this booklet a hands-on resource. (2002)
